ELIGIBILITY:

Admission to Glendale Community College **may** be granted to any person **under the age of 18** who achieves **one of the following**:

1. A composite score of 93 or more on the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT)
2. A composite score of 930 or more on the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT)
3. A composite score of twenty-two or more on the American College Test (ACT)
4. A passing score on the relevant portions of the Arizona Instrument to Measure Standards (AIMS) test
5. Completion of a college placement test designated by the Community College District that indicates the appropriate college level for the course
6. Is a graduate from a private or public high school or possession of a high school certificate of equivalency

Enrollment in **vocational courses** will be considered on a individual basis if the student meets the established requirements of the courses for which the student enrolls and enrollment is in the best interest of the student.

PROOF OF CITIZENSHIP

To qualify for in-state tuition, students must provide proof of lawful presence in the United States. Acceptable documents include a copy of your birth certificate, Arizona drivers license/permit, state ID card, or official immigration papers.
