<b>ASSESSMENT</b>		
Takes, or verbalizes, body substance isolation precautions	1	
Briefly questions the rescuer about arrest events	1

\_\_\_\_\_ Did not immediately direct initiation/resumption of CPR at appropriate times

\_\_\_\_\_ Did not assure all individuals were clear of patient before delivering a shock

\_\_\_\_\_ Did not operate the AED properly or safely (inability to deliver shock)

\_\_\_\_\_ Prevented the defibrillator from delivering any shock
