Official Course Description

This course is designed to train students in the skills of cardiopulmonary resuscitation to include mouth-to-mouth, mouth-to-mask, and cardiac compression, stabilization of adult, child and infant victims with airway obstruction, respiratory, and cardiac arrest. NOTE: this course meets the American Heart Association (AHA) standards for healthcare providers.

AHA Statement

This Internet based e-learning course provides Part 1, the online learning modules of the BLS for Healthcare Providers renewal course. The online learning modules cover all required AHA content. Participants complete the AHA Healthcare Provider exam online. Those successfully completing Part 1 receive a certificate that qualifies them to complete a skills validation session at Glendale College with an AHA BLS instructor. Upon successful completion of Part 1 (online) and the skills validation session at GCC, students will receive an AHA Healthcare Provider course completion card.

Prerequisites

Current AHA Healthcare Provider Level course completion card

Course Competencies

Students must purchase the AHA BLS for Healthcare Providers Online Renewal Course and successfully complete Part 1 online prior to attending the skills validation session. Upon completion of the online learning modules, students will be issued an online certificate. Only students with the online certificate will be allowed to complete the skills validation session. During the skills validation session, students must successfully demonstrate CPR, foreign body airway obstruction, and AED skills according to AHA guidelines.

Evaluation and Remediation

Prior to completing the skills validation session, students will be given a brief opportunity for questions. Remediation will not be provided during the skills validation session. Skills will be evaluated as Pass or Fail. Successful completion of all Healthcare Provider level skills is required in order to receive a course completion card.

Course Schedule / Course Completion

Once the online portion is complete, contact the EMT Dept. at 623.845.3205 to schedule the skills validation session. Students must complete the skills validation session within 60 days of the completion date of Part 1 (online).

Dress

The skills validation session will include bending, kneeling, light lifting and close contact with fellow students and manikins.

Safety

Students are required to exercise due regard for the safety of themselves and others throughout course. Any injuries must be reported to the instructor immediately.

Valuables
