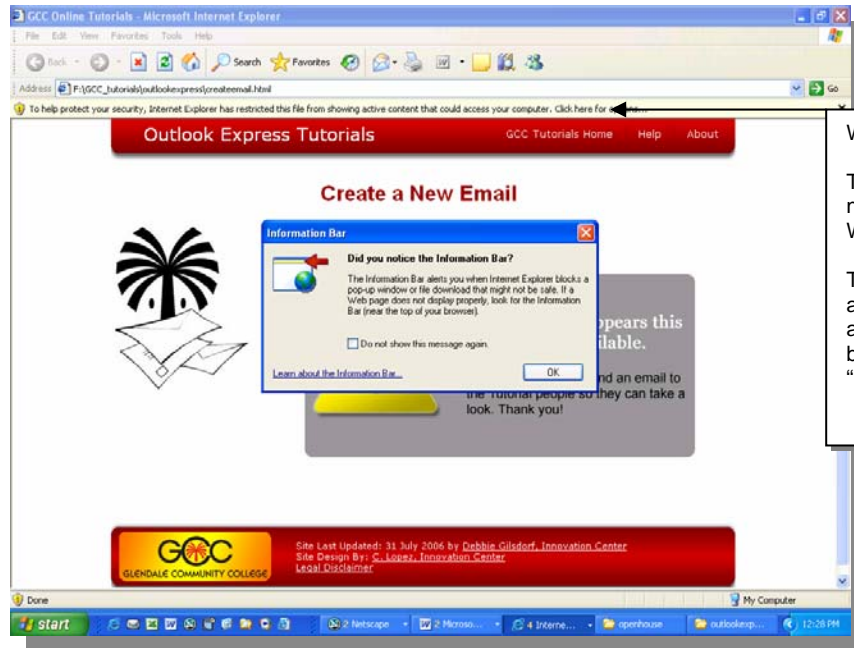


Tutorial Display Instructions:

What is the Information Bar?

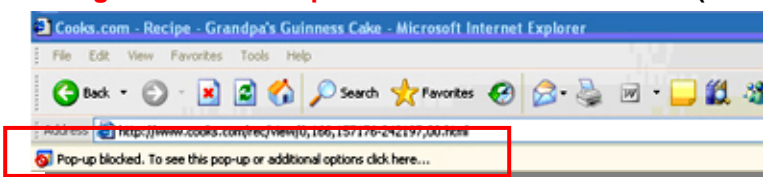
The Internet Explorer Information Bar is a new User Interface that is included in Windows XP Service Pack 2 (SP2).

The Information Bar Window displays alerting you that potentially dangerous actions on a Web page have been blocked. The window also directs you to "notice" the Information Bar.

1. To close the Information Bar Window, click the **OK** button.



2. **Right click the text portion of the Information Bar (not the X.)**



The Information Bar appears between the toolbar and the content window, in Internet Explorer.

NOTE: The information presented in the Information Bar varies depending on the notification that is provided.

After selection, the Information Bar changes to blue and a menu relative to the current notifications opens. Temporarily Allow Pop-Ups from this Site, Always Allow Pop-ups from this Site..., and Settings appear on the menu above.

3. **Select the option that works for you!**

TIP: If you are accessing a web site frequently, you may want to choose, always Allow Pop-ups from this site. By selecting the Always Allow Option, Internet Explorer will still alert you to other web sites presenting potentially dangerous content, but still allow GCC Tutorials/MIDAS to be displayed.
