Student Mathematics League Competition!

What is it?

The **Student Mathematics League Competition** is two multiple-choice tests given to community college students all over the country.

Round One will be Monday, October 26, 2009 at 1:30 pm in MA-126.

Students have exactly one hour to work on the exam and may start the exam any time between 1:30 pm and 2:29 pm. (No student may leave the test room prior to 2:30 pm). The test includes questions from algebra, geometry, logic, and probability (no calculus). The questions are usually challenging in nature. Round 2 will be in February.

- To prepare our students for the competition, we will hold practice sessions every Friday (starting October 2nd) in room MA 104 from 3:00 to 4:00.
- Registration forms and sample questions from previous years' exams are available in the folder at the front desk of the Math Solution.

Why should I?

The obvious answer is because it will look great on your resume. But there are other benefits. Nationally, the first place winner gets a scholarship of \$3000 to the college of her/his choice. At GCC, **the top participant in each round will win a graphing calculator**, provided they have not already won one. The three students who have the highest combined score for both rounds will win scholarships.

First Place - \$500 scholarship
Second Place - \$300 scholarship
Third Place - \$200 scholarship
