YOUR PRESENTATION MUST BE IN A "SKIT" FORMAT, DO NOT LECTURE!

Every member of the group must participate in the skit. If you are not in class when your skit is presented, you can NOT make up the points for the skit. If a group member is missing, the remaining group members are responsible for the information. Each group member will be asked to provide feedback about the participation in the planning of the skit by other group members. What to include in your presentation:

1. How is it acquired?
2. What causes it? (bacteria, virus, organism)?
3. Statistics on the incidence of the STD in US.
4. International statistics about the incidence of the STD.
5. Symptoms in males and females and can it be asymptomatic? (no symptoms) If there are stages, different among the stages.
6. Short and long term consequences in males and females. (including impact on fertility)
7. Is it permanent?
8. How is it diagnosed?
9. Major type of treatment (ie, antibiotics, antifungals, etc, no specific medicine names)
10. Miscellaneous information.

YOU MAY NOT USE NOTES DURING THE SKIT

EVALUATION

1. If the group does well, everyone gets a "10". This includes giving correct information, demonstrated mastery of the material, appropriate speed of presentation, and ability to answer questions.
2. If your group has most of the information correct, but has some incorrect information or your overall presentation is incomplete, everyone gets an "8"
3. If there is lots of misinformation, if your group can't answer questions, or if the presentation is incomplete, everyone gets 6 or less.
4. If group members provide feedback that an individual has not participated in the group planning process, that individual may receive a lower grade than the other group members.
