- Amanda shared information with the group regarding the two recipients of this year's scholarships - Yvonne Martel & Laura Harrel. Both received \$200 from the GCC WLG scholarship fund. Amanda showed the group the thank you notes received from the awardees. We hope to have both recipients present at our April Potluck so that everyone can meet them.
- Pam and Amanda reminded the group that they will be retiring their positions as co-chairs as of this semester. Amanda is leaving for Kentucky very soon, so Pam will be taking over chair duties through the end of this semester. Spring and Sarah will also be finishing their year as District co-chairs. Thus, we are still seeking interested parties to take over local leadership and District WLG representation. Leadership could be an individual chair or a co-chair. Chair could choose to lead only the local group or to also serve as a District rep. The positions are quite flexible. Amanda and Pam chose to serve as co-chairs to lighten the load on each individual and decided to

diversify the leadership by implementing the District Reps position. A new leader could change any or all of this leadership structure. A few people asked what was involved in each of the positions as they currently exist. I am posting the following information (not listed at the meeting) for the information of members reading these minutes:

Campus Co-chairs:

- Communicate with campus administration regarding WLG matters
- Organize & market campus-specific WLG social & networking events (for GCC group only)
- Conduct monthly on-campus meetings (including campus distribution of minutes, monitoring of GCC WLG financial account and communication of events to campus); times can be set-up as deemed appropriate
- Manage and monitor WLG Expendable Scholarship fund
- Collect annual dues (currently \$10 - \$5 to local fund, \$5 to District - - \$5 of each person's dues to be given to District Reps to transport to District)
- Assist district reps in promotion of District WLG events

District Representatives:

- Attend monthly District WLG Council meetings (currently 3rd Mon of the month from 3:00 - 4:30pm at District Office)
- Participate as active members on the District WLG Council (vote as necessary)
- Provide feedback/input from the college level to the district group
- Serve as primary contact(s) for district WLG events (i.e., ticket sales and promotion) with assistance of campus co-chairs
- Responsible for decisions regarding campus participation at district-level events (i.e. serve as leads if choose to do Fall Event, etc.)

II. District WLG News

- Spring Turner reported that the District Executive council has been working with other groups, including a recent visit by a District representative to discuss the possibility of the Bond.
- **The GCC Chapter will be sponsoring the District WLG Networking Event at Linda Rosenthal's home on May 20, 2004.** Organization and planning is being headed up by Sarah Blank and Spring Turner (our District Co-Reps for this year.) We will most likely be needing GCC members to help out with setup and serving on the day of the event. Last year, approximately 125 members attended the event, and, since our total membership has grown significantly since then, we can probably expect more this year.
