- III. NILD - Next Steps Conference will be held in Scottsdale in October. This is a 2nd conference that builds off the NILD Leaders annual conference. Members requested that if Dr. Randolph's office could only fund one conference for our group this year (at \$800+/participant) that we fund a first-time Leaders attendee. Dues are \$10, which includes the \$5 District WLG dues, \$1 for GCC WLG supplies, and a \$4 donation to the WLG Scholarship Fund.
